

BOARD OF EDUCATION POWERS AND DUTIES

- 1.0 The powers and duties of the Board of Education will be as conferred and prescribed by law.
- 2.0 The Board will be responsible for the management of the schools, will adopt and direct the general course of study, and will provide programs in kindergarten through grade 12.
- 3.0 In the interpretation of the powers and duties of the Board, it is understood that the Board will act as a governing body in the determination of general policies for the control, operation, maintenance, and expansion of the public schools.
- 4.0 The Board of Education will delegate administrative matters to the Superintendent.
