

BOARD OF EDUCATION MEMBER AUTHORITY

- 1.0 Members of the Board of Education have authority only when acting as a Board. The Board will not be bound in any way by any action or statement on the part of any Board member, except when such statement or action is in pursuance of specific instructions from the Board of Education.

- 2.0 No Board member, by virtue of his/her office, will exercise any administrative responsibility with respect to the schools or as an individual command the services of any school employee.
