

NOTIFICATION OF BOARD MEETINGS

- 1.0 It will be the policy of the Board to announce all meetings publicly. Except in the event of emergencies, such announcements will be made by the Superintendent/designee in ample time to allow public attendance and will be disseminated in a manner reasonably calculated to notify the general public.
- 2.0 Whenever possible, Board members will receive notice of emergency meetings at least three days in advance. Such notice will include the date, time, location, and purpose of the meeting. The Superintendent/designee will, whenever practical, notify local representatives of the media by the same or faster means as used to notify Board members.
