

EMPLOYMENT OF COACHES AND ADVISORS

- 1.0 The Board believes that participation in extra and co-curricular activities is an important learning experience designed to promote the growth and development of students, to attain high levels of sportsmanship, to develop competitive skills, and to provide instruction in the specific skills and strategies of the activity.
- 2.0 Each selection committee shall consist of no less than three (3) members appointed by the Superintendent or his/her designee.
- 3.0 No applicant will be hired as a coach, assistant coach, or advisor or appointed as a volunteer without Maine Department of Education approval, including fingerprinting and criminal background requirements.
- 4.0 In order to assure proper supervision, the Board requires at least one (1) coach for every twenty (20) players.
- 5.0 No person shall coach more than one level of a sport in any one season.
- 6.0 Hiring of coaches and advisors shall be on an annual or seasonal basis, with no expectation of continued employment in that position.
- 7.0 All coaches and advisors will be recommended for appointment by the Superintendent in consultation with the Administrator supervising the activity, and approved by the Board.
