

STUDENT FEES

Student fees will be required for all extra curricular programs at the high school, middle school and intermediate school for which the school department approves the coach's/advisor's stipend. The only exception will be for service or recognition organizations as determined by the administration.

- A. Any student who fails to pay this fee and/or fails to seek a waiver will be excluded from participation in the program. Students that qualify for free and reduced lunch will be exempt from paying the fee.
- B. The only exceptions will be when activities are an essential component of a special education student's Individual Education Program (IEP) or when the administration grants a waiver because of financial need.

Student fees will be required for student parking privileges at the high school. These fees will be set and posted annually.

- A. Only vehicles with valid State of Maine issued handicapped permits may park in handicapped spaces. All handicapped spaces are subject to a state minimum fine when used by non-handicapped persons.
- B. Visitor parking areas are reserved for that purpose alone. Students are not permitted to park in the visitor parking areas.
- C. The responsibility of finding a legal parking space rests solely with the vehicle operator. Lack of available space in any lot is not an excuse for a parking violation.
- D. A student's parking privileges may be suspended and/or revoked for failure to abide by the administrative procedures in place.

The Superintendent of Schools and/or his/her designee will be responsible for identifying student fees along with developing administrative procedures to implement this policy.

The Board will approve the fees on an annual basis.
